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Future Skills and Interests

Education



16% plan to go back to school in the next year

32% are interested in future training

Job Interests



42% are very interested in receiving job notifications matching their skills and interests

25% are interested in exploring other job opportunities/ looking for other jobs

Most Common Training Interests

- 1 Construction Trades, other
- 2 Adult and continuing education administration
- 3 Ground transportation, other
- 4 Agricultural power machinery operation
- 5 Primary health care nurse/nursing and family practice nurse/nursing



Most Common Job Preferences

- 1 Technical trades and transportation officers and controllers
- 2 Professional occupations in law, education, social, community and government services
- 3 Administrative and financial supervisors and specialized administrative occupations
- 4 Specialized middle management occupations in administrative services, financial and business services, and communication (except broadcasting)
- 5 Legislative and senior managers
