Education



34% completed at least some Post-secondary

53% reported other licenses or certificates

80% currently have a valid Driver's License

Job Status



52% have a job when taking into account **traditional** jobs

(**Traditional skills** jobs include things like fishing, hunting, crafts, guiding)

42% have a job that is closely related to their education, experience and skills

24% plan to go back to school in the next year

34% are interested in future training

Job Interests



51% are very interested in receiving job notifications matching their skills and interests

26% are interested in exploring other job opportunities/ looking for other jobs
