Current Skills and Employment

Education



14% completed at least some Post-secondary

60% reported other licenses or certificates

88% currently have a valid Driver's License

Job Status



55% have a job when taking into account **traditional** jobs

(**Traditional skills** jobs include things like fishing, hunting, crafts, guiding)

25% have a job that is closely related to their education, experience and skills

Future Skills and Interests

Education



41% plan to go back to school in the next year

73% are interested in future training

Job Interests



68% are very interested in receiving job notifications matching their skills and interests

51% are interested in exploring other job opportunities/ looking for other jobs

- 1 Workforce development and training (not for credit)
- 2 Agricultural economics
- 3 Basic computer skills (not for credit)
- 4 Industrial safety technology/technician
- 5 Childcare provider/assistant
