<b>Education &amp; Experiences:</b>	A Bachelor of Science (BScPT) University degree and/or a Master degree (MPT) in physical therapy. Registration with the Physiotherapy Alberta College and Association is required.
<b>Directs:</b>	Physical therapy services with clinical supervision to the Rehabilitation Assistant
<b>Organizational Structure:</b>	The position is reporting to the YTC Rehabilitation Service Coordinator and Health Director for delivery of physical therapy service.
<b>Summary of Duties/Responsibilities:</b>	<p>A Physical Therapist involves the rehabilitation to help the clients recovering from disease, injury or developmental challenges; to reach their fullest physical and functional potential. Physical Therapists are involved in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Evaluation of movement disorders</li> <li>• Assessment, treatment and education of clients concerning issues of physical and functional ability</li> <li>• Implementation of treatment programs to help clients regain optimal physical function and return to former or modified lifestyles.</li> <li>• Working in cooperation with the client and family</li> <li>• Teaching clients and guiding them in therapeutic exercises and activities that increase muscle strength and joint movement and improve coordination and balance</li> <li>• Application of manual therapy and physical agents to treat pain and movement restriction.</li> </ul>
<b>Working Conditions:</b>	Services delivered at Health Unit, Senior's lodge, Client's Home, Daycare, school and other designated areas.
<b>Qualifications:</b>	The qualification of a physical therapist is a four-year university program (BScPT) and/or a two-year Master degree (MPT) in Physical Therapy.
<b>Required skills and abilities:</b>	Physical therapists value independence, have patience and good understanding to deal with sick and disabled people of all ages. They have the ability to motivate clients to achieve their maximum potential. Therapists enjoy working with people and in the team of other professionals.
